Stan & his comrades meet monthly on Aviva's campus to support one another & discuss opportunities within the community.

In the commander's own words, "The JWV moved to Aviva in January 2016, which allowed more than forty veterans to reconnect with their military life. These veterans were unable to attend meetings prior to the move, due to a lack of transportation. Now, they are able to attend meetings & share their stories from WWII to the present. There is so much camaraderie among them & the information provided in the meetings is valuable to all." Together Aviva and the JWV are honored to help provide our veterans a renewed sense of independence & a place they feel supported.

That is why Goodwill Manasota has created a partnership with numerous employers in the community, including Veteran Air Conditioning. Their tagline "Service with integrity, respect and honor," is the culture Kevin Henault, an Army veteran, has created for his business, and is the epitome of his actions, not just for customers – but for the community. Veteran Air was one of the first businesses to help secure employment for individuals coming through the Goodwill's Veterans Services Program, and has provided employment to numerous Veterans. Under the leadership of CJ Bannister, director of Veterans Services, Goodwill Manasota has served more than 1,000 veterans in our community.

Goodwill Manasota is an industry-leading, 501(c)(3), not-for-profit organization that changes lives through the power of work. With the sales of donated goods and philanthropic donations, Goodwill is able to assist people with disabilities and other barriers to employment by providing job skills training and employment opportunities. In 2016, they served 28,207 people, placed 755 people in jobs and assisted 240 veterans as they reintegrated back into the civilian workforce. Goodwill Manasota's economic impact back to the community is worth \$92.1 million. And as the pioneers of the reduce-reuse-recycle movement, Goodwill diverted 40 million pounds out of the landfill.

The Caregiving Place at the Sarasota and Venice Friendship Centers offers an Adult Day Service where care and support are provided for loved ones and their caregivers. The program enables families to keep their loved ones at home, longer. Attendees are provided an inviting place to socialize with others and engage in purposeful activities under the supervision of trained staff. Friendships are made throughout the day, while enjoying a healthy meal at lunch or at snack time. Friendship Centers' veterans program started in 2011, through an agreement with the Veterans Administration that provides assistance specifically for veterans. For families of veterans, the financial support to help pay for this service is invaluable. Honor and recognition of their military service is an important part of daily conversation. The program celebrates patriotic holidays throughout the year and proudly features accomplishments/ stories of these participants. There is a special connection/camaraderie that the veterans have with one another. They are proud of their service and have a deep love of our country. Their presence enriches the Adult Day Service and we are honored to have these brave veterans in the program.

Friendship Centers is a nonprofit network in Southwest Florida with services that meet the needs of people 50 and older. Since the early 1970s the organization has led the country in developing innovative, cost-effective approaches to address the health and wellness needs of older adults.
