people no longer need just an office space for a desk; clients are asking for more of a clubroom, where there is a desk and built ins, but also with surround sound, a billiard table or poker table; clubroom requests are almost a standard now. Another large trend he sees is that clients cannot get enough garage space, all clients want a full garage. "Garage space has become very desirable" says Cooney. Homeowners are seeing the versatility in the space and using them as a multipurpose location for storage as well.

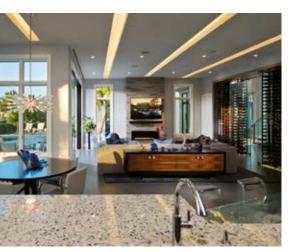

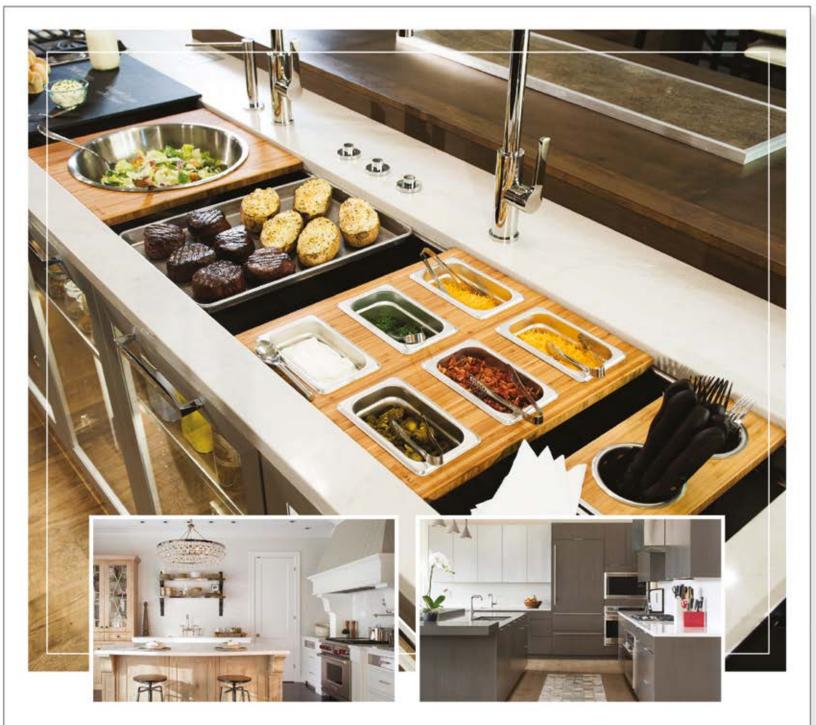
